



A national comprehensive public health approach to addressing individual and community trauma

#### **MISSION**

Set a strategic direction for behavioral health to advance policy, training, practice, research, evaluation, and coordination *across various service sectors* to mobilize and encourage organizations, systems, and communities to implement a trauma-informed approach

#### Strategy 1

Increase efforts and opportunities that support a trauma-informed approach

#### **Strategy 2**

Support communities to implement trauma-informed approaches and initiatives

#### Strategy 3

Increase knowledge and awareness of a traumainformed approach through TA, training, peer-to-peer sharing and resources

Build and foster effective partnerships across the private and public sectors
